From Manchester Piccadilly Station follow signs to Piccadilly Gardens and to the bus terminus. Buses 36, 37 and 38 go along Wardley Hall Road. Ask for the Wardley Hall bus stop. Wardley Hall (about five minutes walk) is signposted from the bus stop.

The tour will commence at 11am and last about 90 minutes. It will include refreshments.

There is minimum disabled access to the ground floor. Access to the upper floors will involve the use of stairs (there is no lift).
